

WHEREAS, Senator Colton Moore has demonstrated commendable courage and foresight in addressing the concerns surrounding District Attorney Fani Willis's conduct and the use of state resources; and

WHEREAS, District Attorney Fani Willis's prosecutorial decisions have sparked significant debate over political impartiality and the judicious use of authority, demanding rigorous examination and potential remedial action; and

WHEREAS, a commission referenced by various political figures as a basis for non-intervention has notably and publicly abstained from investigating District Attorney Willis for her past actions, thereby abdicating its responsibility and undermining public trust in objective oversight;

WHEREAS, the Georgia Republican Assembly (GRA) recognizes the urgent need for transparency, accountability, and adherence to the rule of law in all branches of government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Georgia Republican Assembly:

- Commends Senator Colton Moore for his valiant and astute stance on the necessity for either the defunding or impeachment of District Attorney Fani Willis, aligning with the principles of equitable justice and fiscal responsibility.
- (2) Strongly Condemns the Commission's Inaction, asserting that this failure to investigate District Attorney Willis represents a dereliction of duty and a grave disservice to the principles of justice and impartiality. This inaction by the commission is unacceptable and necessitates direct intervention by our elected officials to uphold the standards of integrity and accountability.
- (3) Urges the Georgia Republican Party (GAGOP) to robustly support Senator Moore, recognizing his commitment to the values that the Party champions. His proactive stance is a reflection of the Party's ethos and deserves unequivocal support from the GAGOP.

- (4) Demands Immediate Reintegration of Senator Moore into the Republican caucus, emphasizing that his exclusion contradicts the Party's commitment to transparency and justice. Senator Moore's insights and integrity are critical in maintaining these values within the caucus.
- (5) Calls for Senate Action on RICO Law Reform, urging senators to support legislative changes to halt the prosecutions associated with former President Trump. This reform is not just a policy adjustment but a fundamental safeguard against the politicization of legal processes. Senators who resist these changes should anticipate vigorous challenges in the upcoming primaries, as adherence to these principles is non-negotiable for the GRA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is endorsed by the GRA Executive Committee and stands as a testament to our unwavering commitment to justice, accountability, and the rule of law.
